#### **Describe Changes:**

- 1. Effective July 1, 2022, the two non-profits (PSW, Inc & MSWETA, Inc) merged into one non-profit. The 'surviving' nonprofit was MSWETA, mainly because it was important to retain the fiscal agent EIN. The name then formally changed from MSWETA to METRO SOUTH/WEST WORKFORCE BOARD, INC (MSWWB) and all staff previously employed by PSW or MSWETA are now employees of the new entity. All required forms are duly filed with the state.
- 2. Currently the workforce board staff, and fiscal/youth staff, are located in two different locations in Marlborough and Framingham respectively. Both office leases expire in December 2022. A lease has been signed for new space in Marlborough and staff from the two locations will be co-located there by the end of 2022. The moves will start in October. The new address is:
